## **Appearance**

8 ft tall, 10 ft wide

densely branched, deciduous shrub

mature stems are hollow with light brown, shaggy bark

## **Foliage**

opposite, simple leaves

hairy underside

## **Flowers**

present mid to late-spring

white to pale-yellow

paired along stem at leaf axils

## **Fruit**

present summer through winter

paired, spherical

red to orange, seedy berries

## **Ecological Threat**

native to Japan

forms monocultures, suppressing native plants

creates dense shade which changes the microclimate

releases chemicals that inhibit other plant growth
