

Morrow's Honeysuckle Lonicera morrowii





# Appearance

8 ft tall, 10 ft wide

densely branched, deciduous shrub mature stems are hollow with light brown, shaggy bark

## **Foliage**

opposite, simple leaves hairy underside

### Flowers

present mid to late-spring white to pale-yellow paired along stem at leaf axils

#### Fruit

present summer through winter

paired, spherical

red to orange, seedy berries

## **Ecological Threat**

native to Japan

forms monocultures, suppressing native plants creates dense shade which changes the microclimate releases chemicals that inhibit other plant growth
