

Oriental Bittersweet

Celastrus orbiculatus





Appearance

perennial deciduous, climbing, woody vine 60 ft. (18.3 m) long, 4 in. (10 cm) in diameter. striated bark, brown to dark brown. smooth glabrous twigs, light grey to dark brown

Foliage

light green, alternate, elliptical to circular leaves 2-5 in. (5-13 cm) long

Flowers

present May to early June small, inconspicuous, axillary, greenish-white

Fruit

green; ripen to yellow; then split to reveal scarlet berries **Ecological Threat**

native to China

vines cover, shade and outcompete other vegetation girdle and kill large trees.
