

Tree of Heaven Ailanthus altissima





Appearance

up to 80 ft tall and 6 ft in diameter smooth, brownish-green bark (young) brown to gray with cantaloupe-like bark (mature)

Foliage

pinnately compound, 1-4 ft with 10-40 leaflets leaflets are lance-shaped with 1-2 protruding bumps crushed leaves give off a strong, offensive odor

Flowers

present in early spring yellow-green, clusters with a repulsive odor

Fruit

present in fall and persist through winter bright orange-red turning brown, large clusters

Ecological Threat

native to Taiwan and central China rapid grower, prolific roots sprouting, hosts the Spotted lanternfly
