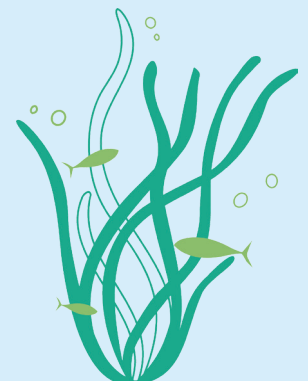


## SEEKING INTERNS APRIL - OCTOBER
